

# Facemask Pattern

As there is a good chance we shall all be needing face masks when they eventually let us out , here is a simple way to make an adult face mask

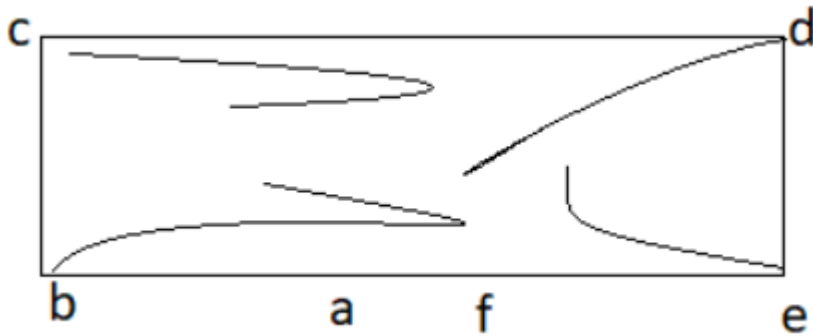
You will need :

2 pieces of light fabric 15" x 7.5"

4 ribbons about 14" each

1 piece of plastic coated wire the width of the mask with a flattened twiddle on each end

Kitchen roll paper for a filter

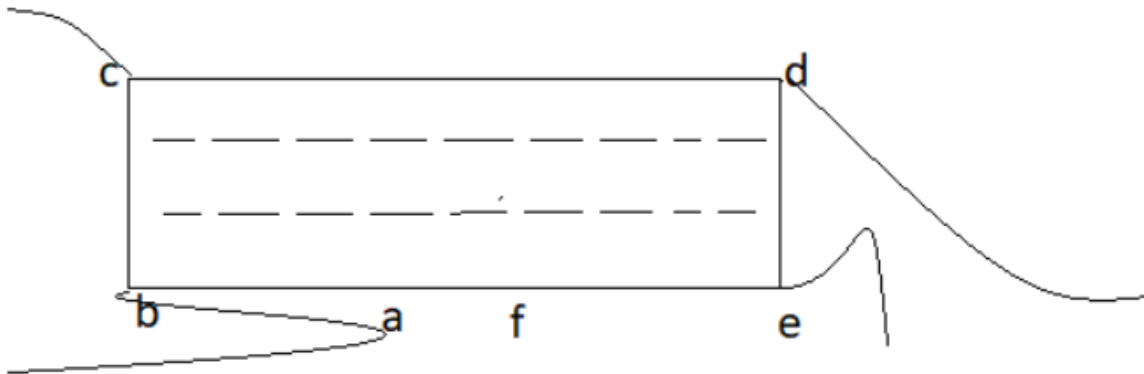


pin a piece of ribbon at b/c/d/and e

cover with second piece of cloth and sew from a-b-c-d-e-f, double stitching at the corners and leaving ribbons clear of the edges except at the corners.

pull the ribbons out through the gap a-f

press then insert the wire through the gap, push it up to the top and seam c-d through both pieces of fabric



make 2 pleats between c and b and d and e, pin and press.

sew all around two rows of stitching from a/b/c/d/e/f

Insert a sheet of kitchen roll as a filter and remove for washing

Tie the ribbons and pinch the wire across the bridge of the nose to fit.

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
